Empowering Louisville Through Enhanced Library Support

Libraries are essential in our ongoing effort to make Louisville a safer, stronger, and healthier city. The Louisville Free Public Library (LFPL) is a cornerstone of our community, playing a pivotal role in the well-being of our citizens, families, and businesses. To fully realize the vision of a thriving and forward-moving city, increased financial support for the library is crucial.

Investing in libraries is investing in Louisvillians. It ensures every community member possesses the tools, resources, and information necessary to flourish. Adequate funding allows libraries to expand their reach and impact, contributing significantly to the overall quality of life in Louisville. To keep our city on a path to success, the Library Foundation supports an additional \$7 Million in library funding in the next fiscal year.

OPERATIONAL FUNDING \$2.5 MILLION

\$500,000 STAFF PARKLAND & PORTLAND LIBRARIES



An increase of \$500,000 in operational funds will facilitate the hiring of essential staff, enabling the reopening of the expanded and renovated Parkland and Portland libraries in Fiscal Year 2025. These dedicated staff members play a pivotal role in bringing these vital spaces to life.

\$2 MILLION GROW OUR COLLECTION, CUT WAIT TIMES



The average wait time for materials at the Louisville Free Public Library has doubled in the last two years, soaring from 12 to 24 days. Concurrently, the materials budget has remained stagnant. An increase of \$2 million in the materials budget will help address this disparity.

\$4.5 MILLION INVEST IN INFRASTRUCTURE



\$4.5 million is needed to complete the projects underway at the Parkland, Portland, Fern Creek, and Main libraries. The Library Foundation is committed to working with legislators, community leaders, and citizens to identify and secure the public and private funds needed to invest in our public library infrastructure and provide equitable services across neighborhoods.
